The mandate of the MCAS is to “encourage, support, and promote the advancement of the Mechanical Contracting Industry in Saskatchewan.”

Our Mechanical Contractor membership is comprised of Plumbing, Heating, Refrigeration, Steam Fitting, Pipe Fitting and Sheet Metal trades. We recognize the industry extends beyond the contractors.
