Since 1919 the Mechanical Contractors Association of Saskatchewan Inc. has been the voice of the Mechanical Contracting industry in Saskatchewan. Through industry advocacy, networking events, education, and services, MCAS is the only trade association focused solely on the needs of the mechanical contractor. The mandate of the MCAS is to “encourage, support, and promote the advancement of the Mechanical Contracting Industry in Saskatchewan.”

Our Mechanical Contractor membership is comprised of Plumbing, Heating, Refrigeration, Steam Fitting, Pipe Fitting and Sheet Metal trades. We recognize the industry extends beyond the contractors. We have also established a Trade Member category for those who work alongside the mechanical trades.
